#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The President of Zoological Society of Pakistan and the Congress Organizing Committee cordially invite the Fellows/Members of the Society and all other scientists interested in various disciplines of Zoological Sciences to take part in the 37<sup>th</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology to be held at the Department of Zoology, GC University, Faisalabad from **February 28 to March 2, 2017**.

#### SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The scientific programme will consist of plenary lectures and oral presentations. Theme of the Congress will cover all the major areas of Zoology and related disciplines *e.g.* Entomology and Pest Management; Cell Biology, Molecular Biology, Bioinformatics, Environmental Biotechnology, Bioremediation, Genetics, Toxicology, Parasitology; Microbiology, Physiology; Palaeontology, Environmental Biology, Wild Life Conservation; Fisheries, Freshwater Biology and Marine Biology.

Fifteen minutes will be allowed for presentation of paper and discussion. Multimedia will be available

The participants are reminded that one author can submit only one abstract as a first author, which he/she will present during academic sessions.

# Last date for the receipt of registration forms and abstracts of papers is 1st January 2017.

#### **ABSTRACTS**

The participants are requested to submit abstracts of their research papers and poster presentations at email address arshaksbs@yahoo.com OR arshakoori.sbs@pu.edu.pk. The abstracts should include a brief introduction, methods used, main results and conclusions. References and figures should not be included in the Abstracts. Please do not forget including your name(s) and addresses, both email and postal.

#### POSTER SESSION

Poster session, as usual, has been arranged specially for the younger scientists. A committee will review the posters and adjudge the first, second and third best posters. The authors of these posters will be given a small cash prize along with an appreciation certificates at the Closing Ceremony.

Participants desirous of presenting posters must, however, register themselves for the congress and submit a short summary by January 1, 2017.

#### GC UNIVERSITY, FAISALABAD

The Government College University's journey started as a primary school in 1897 in the present building of Govt. College for Women, Karkhana Bazar, Faisalabad. It was promoted to High School and Intermediate College in 1905 and 1924 respectively. It was elevated to the degree level in 1933 and postgraduate disciplines were introduced in 1963. The long journey that started with the humble beginning reached its climax when it was granted the status of University in October 2002. The university is situated at the Jhang Road not far from the historical Clock Tower. The main campus is spread on 37 acres and the construction of new campus has been started on an area of 200 acres some 3-4 kilometers away from the main campus at Jhang Road. This university has main campus in the heart of Faisalabad city and four sub campuses (Civil Line Campus, Jhang road Campus (New Campus) Layyah campus, Sahiwal Campus). University has seven faculties and 43 Departments. The Sub Campuses are established to make higher education more accessible to students belonging to remote areas. The Government college University has 12 Directorates. Its education system is annual/Semester/Distance Learning and weekend Programs. This University has affiliation with over 55 Graduates and Post Graduate public sector colleges and 81 private colleges. This University offers BS 4 year and Master, M. Phil and PhD programs in all subjects. GC University also provide evening program, Weekend program and Distance learning in various disciplines at graduate and post graduate level. The fourteenth Prof. Dr. Mirza Azhar Beg Gold Medal will be given to a young researcher upto the age of 45 in Ecology / Wildlife / Vertebrate Pest Management / Taxonomy / Fisheries. A specially constituted committee will scrutinize the applications received in response to an advertisement. The medal will be conferred during the inaugural session of 37<sup>rd</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology.

# PROF. IMTIAZ AHMED GOLD MEDAL

The third **Prof. Dr. Imtiaz Ahmed Gold Medal** will be given to researcher in the field of Entomological Sciences. A specially constituted committee will scrutinize the applications received in response to an advertisement. The medal will be conferred during the inaugural session of 37<sup>th</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology.

# PROF. DR. NASIMA M. TIRMIZI GOLD MEDAL

The tenth **Prof. Dr. Nasima M. Tirmizi Gold Medal** will be given to a researcher in the field of Marine Sciences. A specially constituted committee will scrutinize the applications received in response to an advertisement. The medal will be conferred during the inaugural session of 37<sup>th</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS


Abstracts scheduled for presentation in poster sessions will be grouped by topic, numbered and listed in the programme, and published in the abstract book in the usual manner. In addition, programme listings will specify time when your colleagues may expect you to be at your assigned space to discuss your work.

Mount posters on your assigned board in the evening of February 27, 2017, *i.e.* one day before the scientific sessions of the Congress. Posters should be in place during the full congress period.

The poster board surface is 3'8" high and 5'6" wide. Prepare the top of your poster space with a label indicating its title and authors. The lettering for this section should not be less than 1" high. A copy of your abstract typed in large font, should be posted in the upper left-hand corner of the poster board.

All illustrations should be made before hand. Keep in mind that your illustrations must be read by interested scientists from distances of about 3' or more. Charts, drawings and illustrations might well be similar to those you would otherwise use in making slides; preferably cruder and more heavily drawn. They need not, in fact should not, be "arty." Simple use of color can add emphasis effectively. Do not mount them on heavy board because these may be difficult to keep in position on the poster boards. Hand lettered material should contain appropriately heavy lettering at least 3/8" high. Shade block letters where possible. Typed material should be typed on a Bulletin (large type) typewriter, if possible. Keep illustrative material simple.

Bring your own push-pins or thumbtacks.
